2025 OFFICIAL FLOAT ENTRY CONTEST RULES

1. The following rules govern entries requesting to participate in the City of Crandall's 20th Annual Hometown Christmas Parade.
2. Float entries will be judged on celebrating the 25th anniversary of the movie, 'Dr. Seuss' How the Grinch Stole Christmas':
 - Display of theme ~ anything to do with the movie "Dr. Seuss' How the Grinch Stole Christmas"
 - Creativity and originality
 - Cleanliness and neatness of the area surrounding the entry in the staging area
3. \$100.00 Gift Card and a Trophy ~ Prize
Announcement of Winner and Award
Contest winner will be awarded prior to parade start in the staging area at approximately 9:45 a.m.
4. Parade float contest line-up process and staging will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the high school 'student' parking lot. **All float entries competing in the contest must be in position and ready for judging at 9:15 a.m.**
5. Float judging begins promptly at 9:20 a.m. The float must be presented for judging as it will appear in the parade. There must be someone with the float entry at all times. If no one is with the float entry at the time of judging, it will be disqualified and not judged. All participants on the float do not need to be present for judging unless they are vital to the theme of the float. The decision of the judges is final!
6. Floats must be decorated for a family atmosphere and constructed in a safe manner as well as not present a health or safety hazard to the entrant or the general public.
7. Participants are NOT permitted to jump on and/or off the float entry during the parade, and floats should space at least 20 feet behind entries ahead.
8. Each float entry must display the entry's name or result in point deduction.
9. The float requirements are as follows: A float, for purposes of this contest is:
 - Displays built on or around a trailer being towed manually or by motor vehicle
 - Displays that are self-motorized or that are towed by a motor vehicle
 - Decorated motor vehicles/tractors/golf carts
10. Failure to comply with the parade rules will result in entry member or entire entry removal from the parade.
