Burn Permit Application Type:

_____ 1. Pursuant to a written grant of authority from the state commission on environmental quality or executive director, who, before granting such authority, must determine that there is no practical alternative to outdoor burning, and the burning will [not] cause or contribute to a violation of any federal primary or secondary ambient air standard.

_____ 2. Outdoor burning for the purpose of training firefighting personnel when requested by certified mail and when authorized in writing by the local air pollution control agency or local health unit. If notice of denial from the local air pollution control agency or local health unit is not received within ten (10) days of the request, the burning is authorized.

_____ 3. Outdoor burning consisting of campfires and fires used solely for recreational or ceremonial purposes, or in the noncommercial preparation of food, or used exclusively for the purpose of supplying warmth during cold weather.

_____ 4. Outdoor burning of diseased animals when burning is the most effective means of controlling the spread of disease.

_____ 5. Outdoor burning of hydrocarbons from pipeline breaks and oil spills may be allowed upon proper notification to the city and the executive director of the state commission on environmental quality if it is determined that the burning is necessary to protect the public welfare.

_____ 6. On-site land clearing on lots of greater than one acre upon which the owner intends to clear the lot itself of selected trees, brush and other natural plant growth and when approved by the Fire Code Official, or designee, and the onsite land clearing is conducted in compliance with state, federal and local laws and regulations. A permit shall be required, and approved safety measures shall be employed.
